Founded in 2005, the Mallarmé Youth Chamber Orchestra is a selective and rigorous pre-professional program for students ages 11 to 18, focused on orchestral and chamber music performance. MYCO's orchestras rehearse and perform on a regular basis. Students are also coached in string quartets and other chamber groups by professional chamber musicians, and rehearse under the supervision of highly experienced musicians from the community.

Recently, members of MYCO performed as a piano quartet and also side-by-side with Mallarmé Chamber Players musicians as an octet at a MCP concert in celebration of Mendelssohn's 200th birthday. MYCO musicians also took part in a master class with the Tokyo String Quartet when the latter recently visited Raleigh, and MYCO chamber ensembles played at the Fletcher Opera Theater before performances by the Tokyo String Quartet, Eroica Trio, and the Cuarteto Latino Americano in the pre-concert series organized by the Raleigh Chamber Music Guild.

In 2009, among many other accomplishments by MYCO members, our students won the NC Music Teachers National Association Junior Piano Performance Competition, the Junior Division at the NC American String Teachers Association 2009 State Competition on violin, and the Durham Symphony Young Artists Competition on cello. Last year, one of MYCO's string quartets advanced to the final round of the Fischhoff National Chamber Music Competition, which is the most prestigious chamber music competition for pre-college and young professional groups in the USA.
